Questions to ask your child when reading – Key Stage 1

Before reading the book:

- Can you point to the title? or What is this? (pointing to the title)
- What do you think this story will be about? What might happen in the story?
- What do we call the writing on the back of the book?
 (Blurb) or What does the blurb tell us?

During the reading of the book:

- What is happening in the pictures?
- What has happened so far?
 Is it what you expected to happen?
- What might happen next?
 How do you think the story
 might end? Why do you think
 that?
- What sort of character is....? Is he/she friendly/ mean/ nice...? What words tell you that in the story?

Questions to ask your child when reading – Key Stage 1

At the end of the book:

- Did you like this book? Why? (Encourage children to develop their opinion about books by encouraging them to explain their reasons)
- What was your favourite part? Why?
- What was the most interesting/ exciting part of the book? Can you find it?
- What sort of character was....?
- Why did that character do ... (give a situation/ event from the story)?
- What happened in the story?
