

What to expect in Lower Key Stage 2

Developing reading fluency: children will be reading regularly and develop their understanding and love of texts. They will apply their wide sight vocabulary and use a range of strategies to decode words. Developing writing skills: Children will continue to work on the spelling patterns they have begun in previous years. There will be more of an emphasis on understanding and learning the spelling rules, as well as attention to prefixes and suffixes. Grammar skills will continue to be at the forefront of writing units.

What to expect in Lower Key Stage 2

- Developing mathematical skills:
 - In Class 2, there will be a lot of focus on times tables as they form the foundation for a large majority of the work the children will cover in the year.
 - Children will be taught using the 'mastery' style whereby children are encouraged to use their understanding of the new conceptions to solve challenges to deepen their understanding.

- 25 times tables questions
- Designed to assess whether pupils can recall their times tables fluently.
- Speed and accuracy are important.
- TTRS and paper-based times table questions will support children to develop confidence and fluency.
- It is beneficial for children in Year 3 to also be practising their times table as much as possible.
