Democracy	<p>Pupils are encouraged to take into account the views of others in shared activities and realise that all viewpoints are valid.</p> <p>The MFL Curriculum provides opportunities for children to learn about how different cultures and countries make decisions and participate in democratic processes. For example, they can learn about the voting system in France or the role of the European Union in promoting democracy</p>
Rule of Law	<p>Children will understand that there are certain basic, fundamental truths that are common to our humanity, such as the need for honesty, trust and mutual respect in order for us all to live together in harmony.</p> <p>Children are taught to value the rule of law and democratic systems that European countries and countries further afield enjoy despite the varied customs, festivals and national characteristics that makes every society so unique.</p>
Individual Liberty	<p>Children are taught that there are other ways to live and behave which are valid, despite not being the same as the one that the child knows at home.</p> <p>Children are encouraged to see the importance of personal expression and communication.</p> <p>Children can learn how to express themselves in another language and how to communicate with people from different cultures.</p>
Mutual Respect for and tolerance of those with different faiths and beliefs	<p>We will provide opportunities to learn about, experience and talk about different cultures, traditions and religious beliefs.</p> <p>Children will learn about language and culture in a global context and will be encouraged to respect these.</p> <p>We will ensure that children hear and discuss unbiased and uncritical viewpoints of other faiths and beliefs.</p> <p>Children will experience and learn to appreciate different cultures, festivals, traditions and celebrations through MFL.</p>
