#### Children's Mental Health Week

#### **Safer Internet Day**

Tuesday is Safer Internet Day and children will be adding to their usual Internet safety learning through PSHE by undertaking a BBC Live lesson at 11am, which will focus on understanding and navigating AI technology safely. Classes will also be taking part in different activities through the day.
