Internet Safety Day

Coram Life Education workshops

Each class took part in a session throughout the day focusing on ways to understand ourselves and how



to support others. Class 1 looked at 'My Wonderful Body', where they looked at the parts which make



up our body and how we use our energy. They also talked about ways to tackle difficult situations with friends and how honesty is important. Class 2 had a session on 'Meet the Brain' and Class 3 looked at 'Friends'.

Class 1 Science Exploration Day

For our first science lesson, exploring light, we established that sun is an important light source in the daytime and that other light sources are used at night. We looked at the difference between 'light reflectors' and 'light sources' and sorted different objects into the







correct categories. We practised the key scientific skill of recording our findings in a Carroll Diagram to identify if an object is a 'light source' or a 'light reflector' and whether the object is 'man-made' or 'natural'.

DeVere Hotel Leap Year Charity Day

We have worked with the team at the Devere Cotswold Hotel lots over the last year: they hosted us for our



fieldwork day in the Summer term; invited our Eco Ambassadors to join their Green Team board meeting and invited us to take part in their lake litter pick in the Autumn. This time, the team came to us and kindly gave the school their leap year charity day. 6 team
