Swimming finance

Following on from last week's update I am writing to request that if you know that you are not going to be able to pay for school swimming which starts next term please can you let me know. School budgets are very tight and we are restricted in our use of grants such as sports premium and pupil premium to support school swimming. We will need to review our swimming provision for the rest of this year and next if contributions do not match expenditure.

Homework

This is a little reminder about homework, all children are requested to read to an adult each night and have their reading sheet signed. If your child has finished their book and is not able to quiz at home then that can then be done the following morning at school. Please do let us know if your child needs to change their book.

Spellings are sent home each week and link to their phonics in school or gaps in their spelling of key words per year group. Spelling assessments are carried out termly based on the words that have been taught in class and sent home for practice. Times tables are set weekly for all children from year 2 upwards, if your child is not able to do this online please ask for a pack of sheets to be sent home which can then be handed in weekly. If you are struggling to support your child at home with their learning please do come and speak to myself or their class teacher and we will make a plan.
