Make connections:

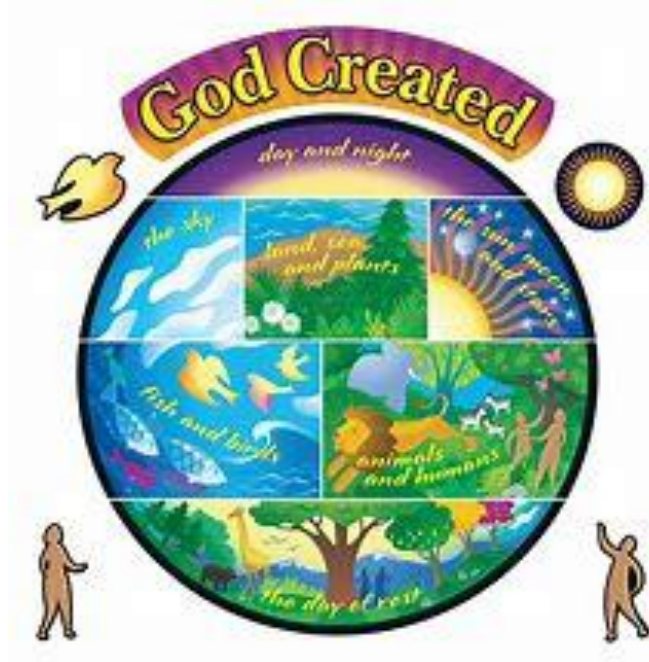
- Think, talk and ask questions about living in an amazing world.
