On Tuesday, class 3 travelled to the Dean Heritage Centre for an Anglo-Saxon day. The children were able to see how everyday Anglo Saxons lived and compare this to the information they had learnt at school about the richer Anglo Saxons from source evidence from burial chambers. The day included learning about weapons and how to defend themselves, medical equipment and how to look after themselves as well as a walk through an ancient woodland to look for signs of wild boar and items that they could gather. We really enjoy the opportunity to take the children on trips and are very grateful to the PTA for supporting one school trip per class this year to keep the costs down.
