#### Fun digital therapy for childhood anxiety

Lumi Nova is a therapeutic game that helps children aged 7-12 years self-manage worries and build resilience. You just need to sign up for free with your details. <a href="https://luminova.app/">https://luminova.app/</a> Lumi Nova: Tales of Courage is an engaging child-led, parent/guardian-supported therapeutic intervention that can be used on most smartphones or tablets.

It facilitates graded exposures (the active ingredient of Cognitive Behavioural Therapy) with psychoeducation to empower 7-12-year-olds with mild to moderate needs to learn to self-manage fears, worries and anxiety.

It is **practical**, **age-appropriate**, **and non-stigmatising**, **encourages self-management** and provides user progress and health outcomes **data in real-time** to authorised professionals.
