Would you be interested in joining a Junior Parkrun on Sunday mornings at Hatherop Castle?

If you're not aware of [Parkrun](#), it's a free, fun, friendly, weekly, community event organised by volunteers of all ages. The Junior Parkrun (held on Sunday mornings at 9am) is a 2km run for children aged 4 to 14. It's a great way of getting children outdoors and motivated, with a true community feel. Although it's timed, the focus is firmly on participation rather than racing.

There are Junior Parkrun events run throughout the country, but there are limited opportunities in the Cotswolds, particularly in the vicinity of Cirencester and Fairford - the nearest junior events are in Witney and Swindon. Hatherop Castle School (just north of Fairford) has been approached about hosting an event in their school grounds, and given the benefits to children and the community, are keen to support it if there is sufficient interest to make it viable. There is a huge amount of work to get a new event set up, so they're keen to assess how popular it might be, to ensure it's worthwhile.
